Santa Cruz County Take-it-Back Partnership Takes On Fluorescents

The Take-it-Back partnership in Santa Cruz now provides County residents with a no-cost opportunity to properly recycle fluorescent lamps, including tubes and compact fluorescent lamps (CFLs).

All fluorescent lamps contain a minute amount of mercury which can harm the environment if the bulbs are not recycled properly. See EPA's Fact Sheet on Mercury Lamps. Over a dozen local lamp retailers now take back lamps in their

stores from residents at no charge. Businesses may return used fluorescent lamps to any local HHW site for a small fee.

Local governments provide funding for fluorescent lamp recycling. The program is coordinated by the County Public Works Department. Initial funding was provided by the Pacific Gas and Electric Company.

NEVER throw your used fluorescent bulbs in the trash or recycling! Take them to one of the stores below at no cost.

Limit: 10 bulbs per day. Compact fluorescents and tubes up to 4' length accepted.
