



MAIN STREET AND BRIDGE STREET IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Project Description:

The Project will construct roadway, pedestrian and bicycle improvements along Main Street from Bridge Street intersection to approximately 600' south of Sevilla Drive. Improvements along Main Street are primarily located on the west side of the street and include construction of sidewalk, curb and gutter, curb ramps and high visibility thermoplastic striping, markings, and signing. The purpose of this Project is to enhance the overall pedestrian and bicyclist safety along Main Street near the Main Street Elementary School.

What to Expect During Construction:

During construction, the County of Santa Cruz Department of Public Works will work closely with the Contractor to minimize inconveniences, however you should anticipate the following:

- ✓ **Traffic Delays** will be kept to a minimum; however, traffic delays may be expected at various times during construction.
- ✓ **Parking** in some places maybe temporarily restricted.
- ✓ **Driveways** maybe temporarily restricted when construction is occurring in the immediate area.
- ✓ **Noise and Dust Levels** will likely increase temporarily.
- ✓ **Disturbance** of improvements, including fencing and landscaping, located within the County's right-of-way and temporary construction easement areas may occur.
- ✓ **Mail Service** will be temporarily affected during construction.



These impacts will be minimized by the following measures:

- ✓ **Hours of Construction will be limited to weekdays, 7:30 AM to 5:00 PM.**
- ✓ **Traffic Management** will occur. Temporary lane closures may occur between the hours 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM and will be restricted further while school is in session. Traffic will be controlled by flag persons when lane closures occur. All attempts will be made to keep both lanes of traffic open and maintain pedestrian access during construction.
- ✓ **Advance Written Notice** will be provided prior to restricting access to driveways and temporary shutdown of utilities.
- ✓ **Parking** will be limited in the area of immediate construction. "No parking" signs will be posted along the street identifying the areas with temporary parking restrictions.
- ✓ **Dust Control** will occur, as water and sweeper trucks will be used to limit the dust.
- ✓ **Construction Signage** will be posted to provide information about the project.
- ✓ **Disturbance** within the County's right-of-way and sidewalk easement areas will be limited to that amount necessary to construct the improvements.
- ✓ **Mailboxes** will be temporarily relocated during construction and placed along the east side of the Main Street.
