MOUNTAIN CHARLIE ROAD PM 3.63 STORM DAMAGE REPAIR PROJECT Road Closure to Begin

The County of Santa Cruz Department of Public Works has announced that storm damage repairs will commence at post mile 3.63 on Mountain Charlie Road, which will be subject to a lane closure, intermittent full closure, and traffic delays. Work can be expected to begin as early as Tuesday, May 19th, and is expected to last through the middle of July 2022. One lane will be closed, and traffic will be controlled using flaggers and stop signs.

The road will occasionally be closed for up to an hour Mondays through Fridays, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., and from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 pm.

These lane closures, road closures, and delays are necessary for the construction of a soldier pile retaining wall and roadway improvements. The Department of Public Works would like the motoring public to avoid these areas if possible and to expect delays.
